

## **BINGO!**

(Secondary)



- 1. Each player will receive an empty 5x5 scorecard.
- Players will have to choose 25 out of 30 options and put one in each square. The players only need to write codes (X\*\*) that represent the options. Players need to use TEXT/DRAW to write and cross out the options. Use ERASER, REFRESH, or UNDO to edit the lines.
  - 3. The **options cannot be repeated**. Each option represents the answer to a question.

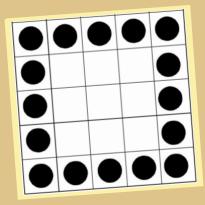
## **BINGO!**

(Secondary)



- 4. The host will spin the spinner to determine each player's turn.

  For every player's turn, they have to call out a number from 1 to 30. Once the number is chosen, the host will read out the question of that number. As the host calls out the answer, players who have that option on their cards mark it off with a cross (X) using draw option in whiteboard chat.
  - 5. As the game progresses, the host will ask if anyone gets a bingo.
  - 6. The winner is the first person to mark off the options in the shape of a square (top, left, right and bottom) and shout BINGO!.



7. The host continues the game to find the second and third place winners.
