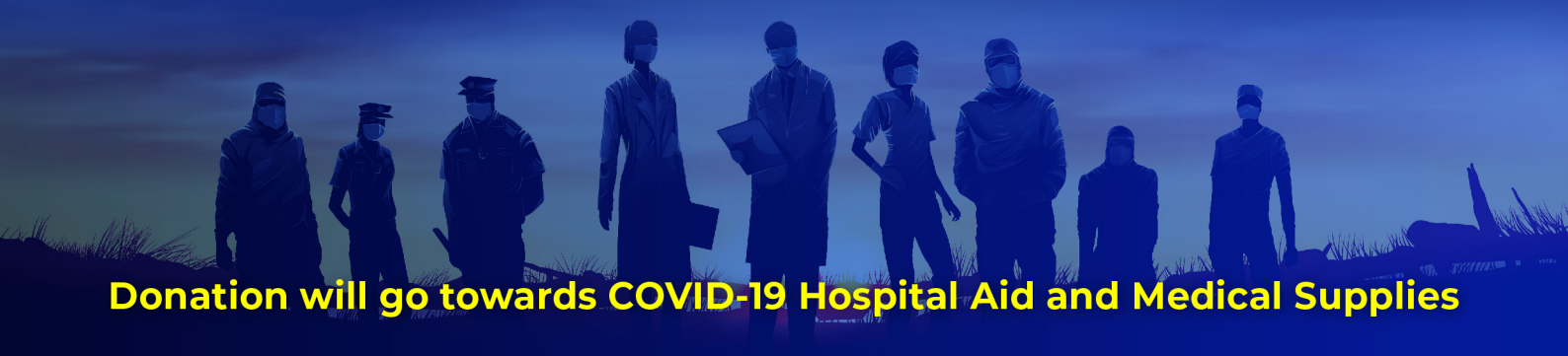

Terms & Conditions

1. The IDRISSE Charity Colouring Competition (the "Competition") is open to children aged 3 years old and above residing in Malaysia (the "Participant").
2. The competition period is from **9th August 2021 until 27th August 2021**. We must receive the artwork submission by 11:59 PM on 27th August 2021. Result will be announced on **30th August 2021** at 08:00 PM via IDRISSE School Instagram and Facebook page.
3. To enter the competition, each participant is required to make a payment of RM10 for the registration fee and the all fees collection will go towards COVID-19 hospital aids and medical supplies.
4. Each participant in **Category A (3-6 years old)**, **Category B (7-9 years old)** and **Category C (10-12 years old)** has to download, print and colour in the drawing based on the categories that the participant falls in. Participants in these categories are allowed to use colour pencil and crayon.
5. Each participant in **Category D (13-17 years old)** has to draw and colour their own artwork based on the 64th year Merdeka theme, "Malaysia Prihatin". Each participant must choose to draw a 2-dimensional artwork based on any of the themes provided:
 - (1) **Life is Hard: Overcoming The Adversities Together.**
 - (2) **Kindness Beyond Borders: Nothing is Too Little.**
 For this category, participants may use A3 size paper for watercolour illustration, or 300 DPI at 3508 x 4961 pixels for digital illustration. Photography and video are not accepted.
6. The artwork must be the participant's original artwork and not the artwork that was previously published on any type of media including social media, or submitted to other competitions. Any kind of plagiarism of artwork will not be tolerated.
7. Each participant may only send **ONE (1)** completed artwork to the competition and only online submission to bit.ly/IDRISSI_SUBMISSIONColoring will be accepted.
8. Each participant has to submit the entry individually. Entries on behalf of another person or group participation are not allowed.
9. Each participant may scan the completed artwork in a **.JPEG file** with file size not less than 1MB and not exceeding 5MB.
10. If there is no access to the scanner, the participant may take a picture of the artwork or download CamScanner App from Google Playstore / App Store.
11. Make sure the artwork is properly captured with the right angle and lighting. Images of artwork that is taken with a shadow cast / tilted / blur / too small will not be accepted.

12. Submission that does not follow the guideline will result in disqualification.
13. When registering and submitting the entry, each participant must provide the correct details. IDRISSE School (the "Organizer") will only use the information to check the participant's eligibility, prize-giving purpose and give the rightful ownership of copyright of the participant's work. The organizer takes no responsibility for delayed or incomplete registration and entries.
14. **THREE (3)** winners among the participants will be selected per category and cash prizes worth RM RM2,000 are to be won. Requests for prizes substitution will not be entertained.
15. Submitting the entry means that each participant accepts these terms and conditions as the competition's rules and regulations.
